

Halewick Lane: Your Ideas

The development of the site may need to include a mix of different uses. These have been divided into three groups as a start to thinking about what could go on the site and to get your ideas;

Community

New facilities could be provided for Sompting that could also serve the nearby open spaces. These could include;

- A meeting and event space for social functions, youth facilities and indoor recreation and activities
- An education space for local schools, evening classes and visitors to the Park
- A café

Leisure and recreation

Leisure and recreation facilities could be provided to meet local needs, provide local business opportunities and attract tourism to the area. These could include;

- A riding school which supports the Riding for the Disabled Association
- Facilities to support and encourage walking and cycling in the Park
- Tourism

Employment

Employment uses on the site may help support the other community uses and bring jobs and business opportunities to the area. This could include a range of flexible spaces to support small businesses and nurture local enterprise, providing employment opportunities for the local community with;

- Start-up units
- Studios
- Craft and small scale manufacturing
- Park related businesses
- Small scale creative, IT and design
